This website uses "cookies". A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by our web page server. Cookies are widely used to make websites work more efficiently as well as to provide web services and functionalities Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer and are safe.

Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. The majority of web browsers will allow you to alter the settings used for cookies and to disable and enable them as you require. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience our website.

None of the cookies on our website collect or store personal data, and we only store standard internet data for our internal reporting purposes. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the website. We collect this information in a way which does not identify anyone, keeping your privacy as well as allowing us to improve the website wherever possible.
